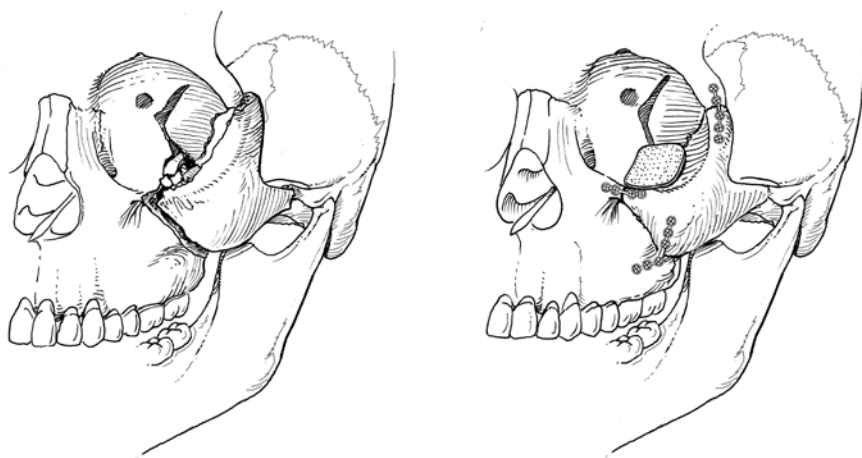

Overview

This educational activity will focus on interdisciplinary problem-solving in cranio-maxillofacial surgery and will be of interest to oral and maxillofacial surgeons, otolaryngology–head and neck surgeons and plastic surgeons. 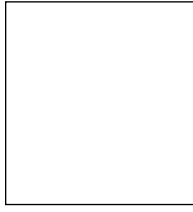
