## Interdisciplinary Problem Solving in Facial Trauma and Obstructive Sleep Apnea

### Summary of Need

In recent years, technological advances have changed management algorithms in facial trauma and have improved surgical interventions. Most surgeons are aware of only a limited number of these advances and few communicate their experiences across disciplines. Indeed, no symposium in the region has ever invited specialists from different disciplines to share their expertise in the management of facial trauma. This symposium on interdisciplinary problem solving in facial trauma will update participants on the latest techniques and instrumentation developed to improve patient outcomes in facial trauma while fulfilling the need for improved communication across disciplines in order to optimize patient care.

### Overall Purpose

This course will focus on interdisciplinary problem-solving in facial trauma and will be of interest to otolaryngology-head & neck surgeons, plastic surgeons and oral and maxillofacial surgeons. Advanced technologies used to solve problems will be highlighted, as well as indications, complications, and peri-operative considerations. Teaching methods include focused interdisciplinary panel discussions of controversial clinical issues and case studies, along with presentations of basic concepts, fundamentals of internal fixation, and preoperative case management.

### Educational Objectives

At the completion of this activity, the participant should be able to:

- 1) Discuss controversial topics in facial trauma and recognize difference in subspecialty approaches and surgical techniques.
- 2) Effectively utilize current or new technology and instrumentation in treating cranio-maxillofacial fractures.
- 3) Identify co-morbidities or complications that arise when treating facial trauma, then implement timely intervention.
- 4) Stratify and categorize patients with Obstructive Sleep Apnea (OSA) based on sleep studies and other clinical criteria.
- 5) Identify which patients with OSA may benefit from surgical treatment.
- 6) Appropriately select a specific surgery that addresses the main anatomic or functional abnormality in the OSA patient.

### Target Audience

Surgeons and Dentists (including residents), nurses and allied health professionals practicing in the fields of oral and maxillofacial surgery, otolaryngology-head and neck surgery, and plastic surgery.
