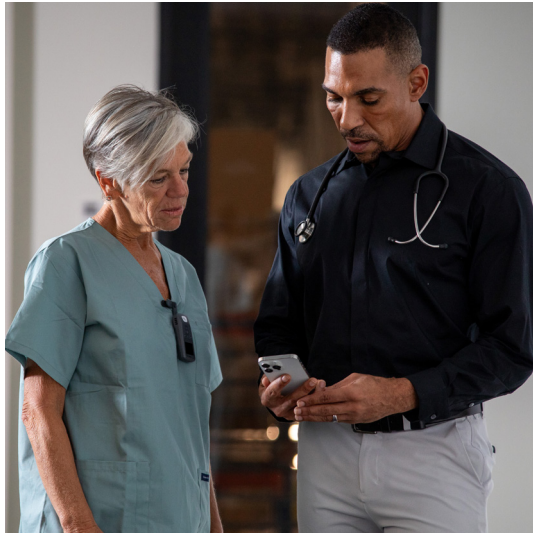

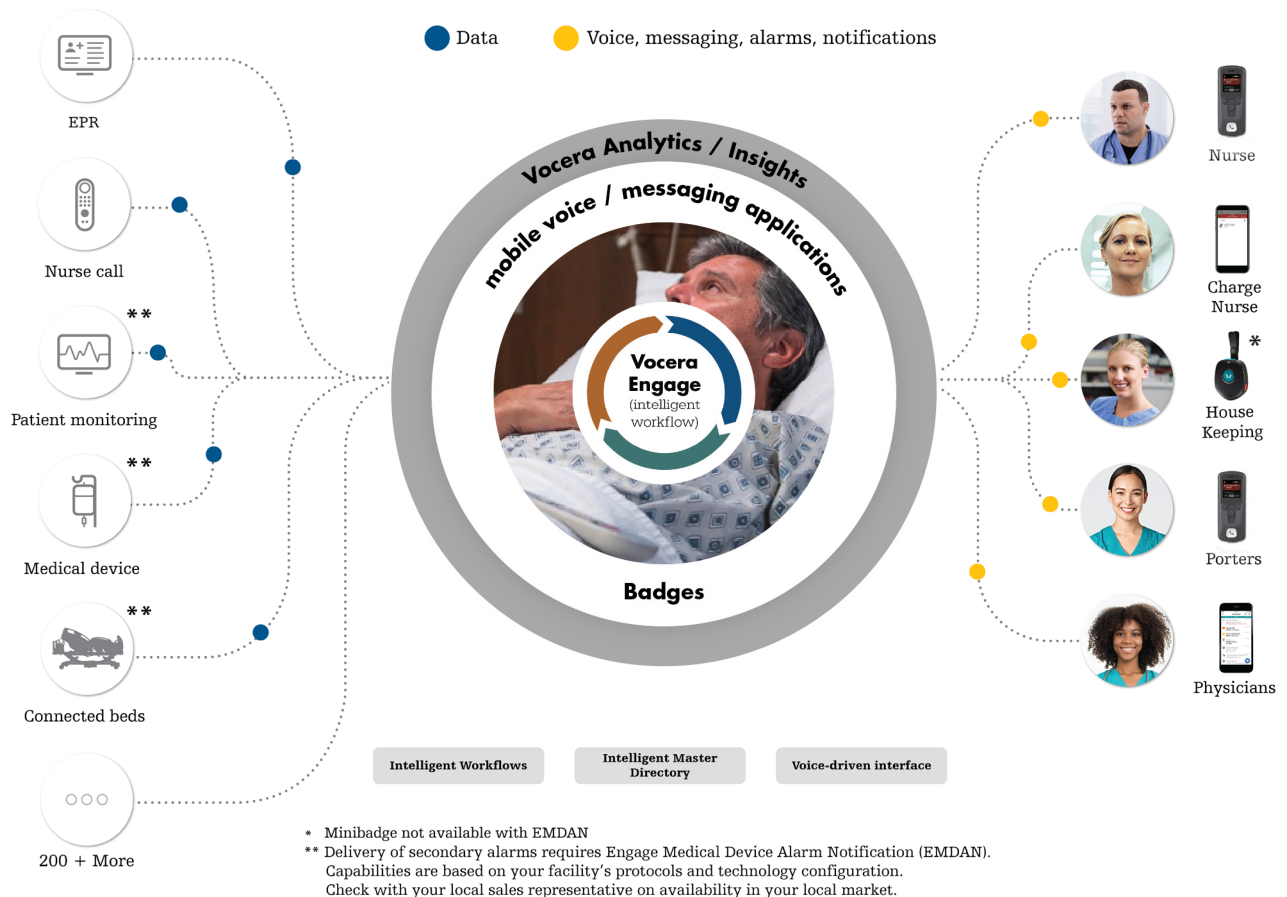

Vocera Engage is the intelligent core of the Vocera Clinical Communication and Workflow Platform and includes Engage Medical Device Alarm Notification (EMDAN) middleware. It's design enables routing, escalation and prioritisation of communications and alarm notifications that include context about the patient, event and care team.

Delivery of notifications is enabled by interoperability with your clinical and operational systems and according to rules your organisation sets. Prioritisation is based on your facility's protocols and technology configuration.

Engage enables more than 200 integrations with clinical and operational systems. It also enables integration with the Dynamic Master Directory, which provides a "near real-time" view of patients and staff. Our Master Directory goes beyond EHR/EMR assignment data to make it easy to reach the extended care team<sup>†</sup>.

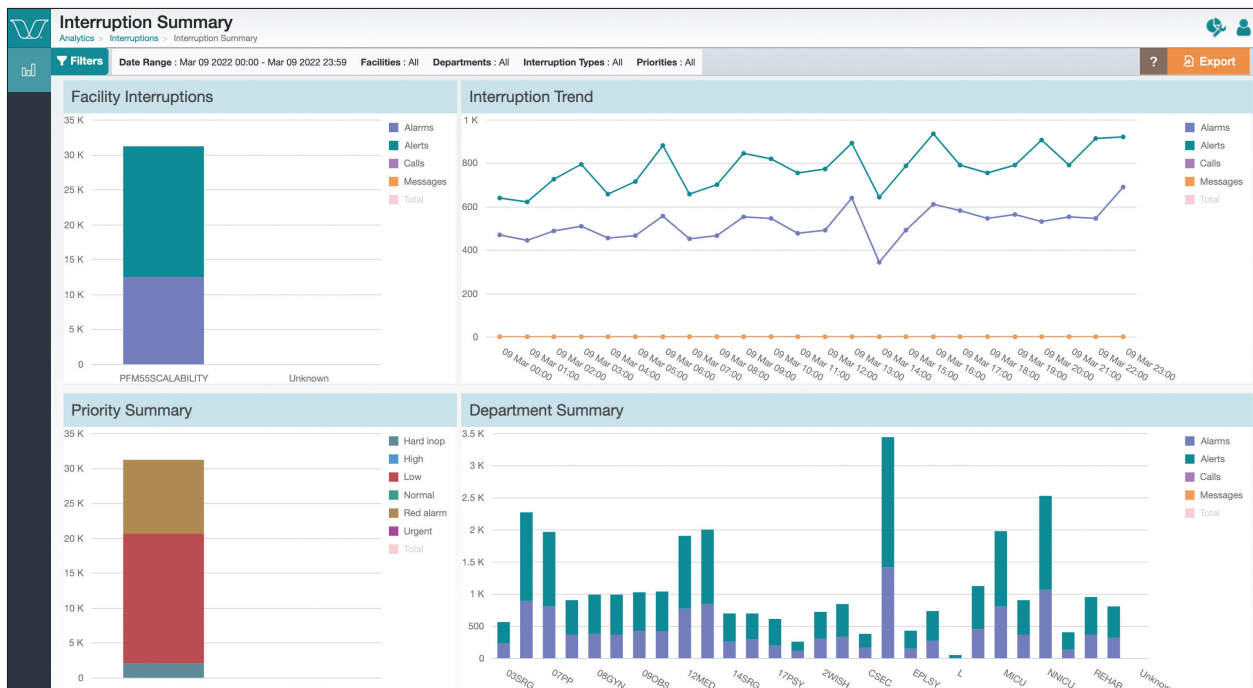
