We are actively assessing potential business impact across our global supply chain and taking measures to help mitigate risk to our product supply.

What steps is Stryker taking to maintain product supply?

We have business continuity plans that manage risk to manufacturing and raw material supply and ensure that we are making every effort to maintain product supply and meet customer needs. If a product or raw material is deemed at risk, we will execute these contingency plans, including seeking alternative suppliers, expediting shipments and reallocating raw materials and/or finished goods from other parts of our global network.

This is a changing and dynamic situation that we are monitoring very closely. We will continue to prioritise the safety of our employees, customers and communities in all supply chain decisions.
