Packaging information

Use:

Skin protectant barrier.

Instructions:

Peel open label without completely removing it. If desired, warm entire package in the microwave (1000W) no longer than 45 seconds. Caution: Test temperature of cloths prior to use. Wait if excessively hot. Cleanse soiled area using a fresh cloth. Discard cloth after use - DO NOT FLUSH. Usa as often as necessary, especially if prolonged exposure to wetness is anticipated. Reseal label between uses. Discard package immediately if cloths are dry. Dimethicone: Acts as a skin protectant barrier.

Contraindications:

This product should not be used by patients that have sensitivity to chlorhexidine digluconate or any of the ingredients in this product. Do not use if irritation, sensitisation, or allergic reaction occurs.
