To offload the heel

Put the heel protector on

The heel protector is shipped **inside out**. Position heel over opening on grey side. Pull sides up around foot and toes.



Tighten straps

Wrap straps around the heel protector and adjust.

Do not over tighten.



Make sure the heel is floated



To use with sequential compression device:

Run tubing through the nearest available port.

Ensure tubing is not kinked or contacting skin.

Push tubing down into seams when using side ports.

Do not use heel hole as a port.
