

The system offers a comprehensive solution for degenerative disc disease (DDD) up to a Grade I spondylothesis. This offers a solution to restore and maintain disc height and achieve sagittal balance in the lumbar spine. For all indications, the Aleutian implants are intended to be used with supplemental internal fixation appropriate for the implanted level.









Bilateral Aleutian AN Lordotic Interbodies pictured with the Mesa Degenerative Spinal System
