


# **Force Fiber**

It is a non-absorbable suture composed of ultra-high molecular weight, polyethylene fiber allowing for a durable and strong solution.

- Designed to offer greater tensile strength than polyester and polyblend sutures, Force Fiber is excellent for ligation of soft tissue to bone.
- Lubricious for smoother, more efficient performance so that each knot may slide right down onto the last even when space is tight.
- Blue co-braid design for increased visibility in the joint.
- Available with Taper, Cutting, or K-Point needles.




# **XBraid**<sub>IT</sub>

 $XBraid_{TT}$  is a smooth, low profile, 100% ultra-high molecular weight polyethylene suture tape designed to increase tendon-to-bone contact in soft tissue repairs. The custom design of the  $XBraid_{TT}$  allows the suture to lie flat against the tissue to increase the suture footprint.

- $XBraid_{TT}$  is a tie-able tape with comparable knot stacks to #2 suture.
- Designed with lubricity in mind,  $XBraid_{TT}$  easily slides after anchor insertion and during knot tying.
