

SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR STRYKER CORPORATION WELFARE BENEFITS PLAN

This is a summary of the annual report of the Stryker Corporation Welfare Benefits Plan (Employer Identification Number 38-1239739, Plan Number 501) for the plan year 01/01/2021 through 12/31/2021. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Stryker Corporation has committed itself to pay certain health, dental, prescription drug, vision and temporary disability claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

Insurance Information

The plan has insurance contracts with Blue Cross And Blue Shield Of Alabama, Cigna Health And Life Insurance Company, Life Insurance Company Of North America, Hartford Life And Accident, Kaiser Foundation Health Plan Inc And Hawaii Medical Service Association to pay certain health, prescription drug, dental, vision, employee assistance program, life insurance, long-term disability, accidental death and dismemberment, medical benefits abroad claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending 12/31/2021 were \$17,106,510.

Because they are so called "experience-rated" contracts, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending 12/31/2021, the premiums paid under such "experience-rated" contracts were \$674,713 and the total of all benefit claims paid under these experience-rated contracts during the plan year was \$625,277.
