Design rationale

The Tornier HRS Humeral Reconstruction System was developed to address unmet clinical needs within the **spectrum** of revision shoulder arthroplasty. The modular functionality of the Tornier HRS Humeral Reconstruction System allows surgeons to create constructs that address **unique anatomies**, which include proximal humeral bone loss, while also allowing for use in primary anatomic or reversed configuration, as well as **convertible** between anatomic and reversed configurations.

- Drill bits



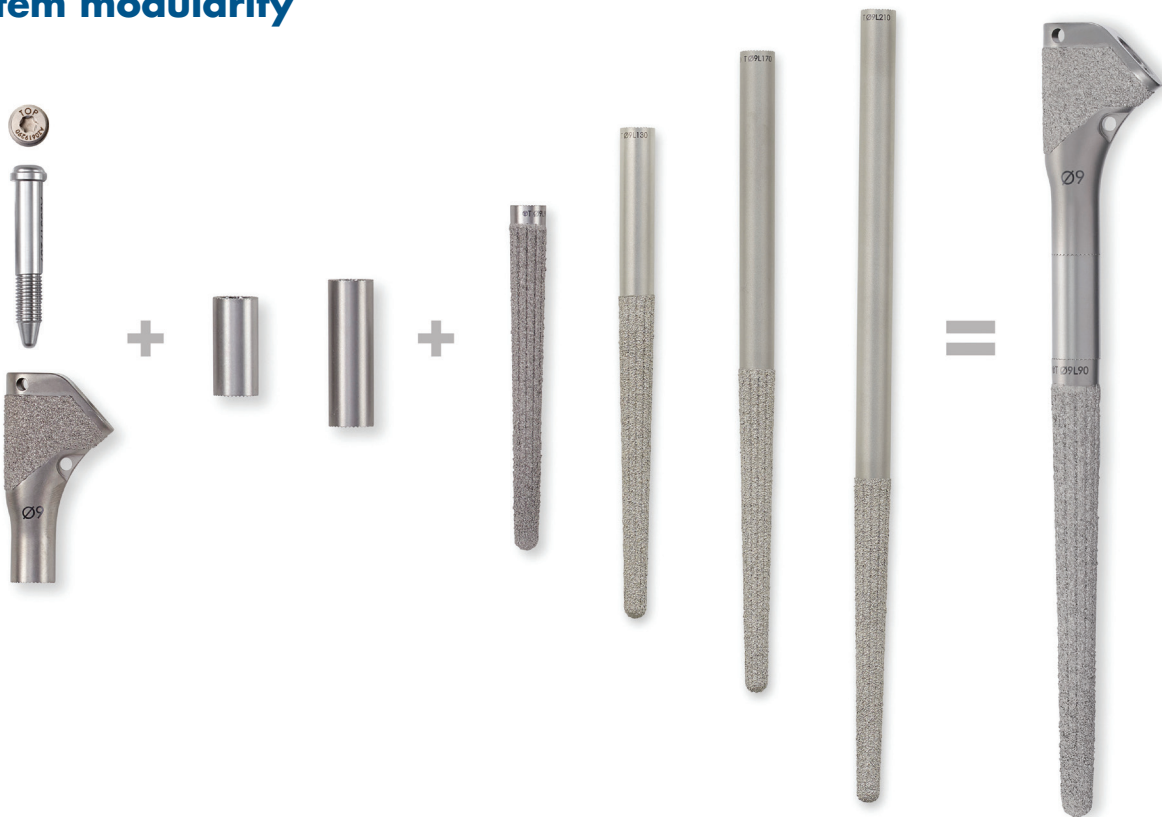

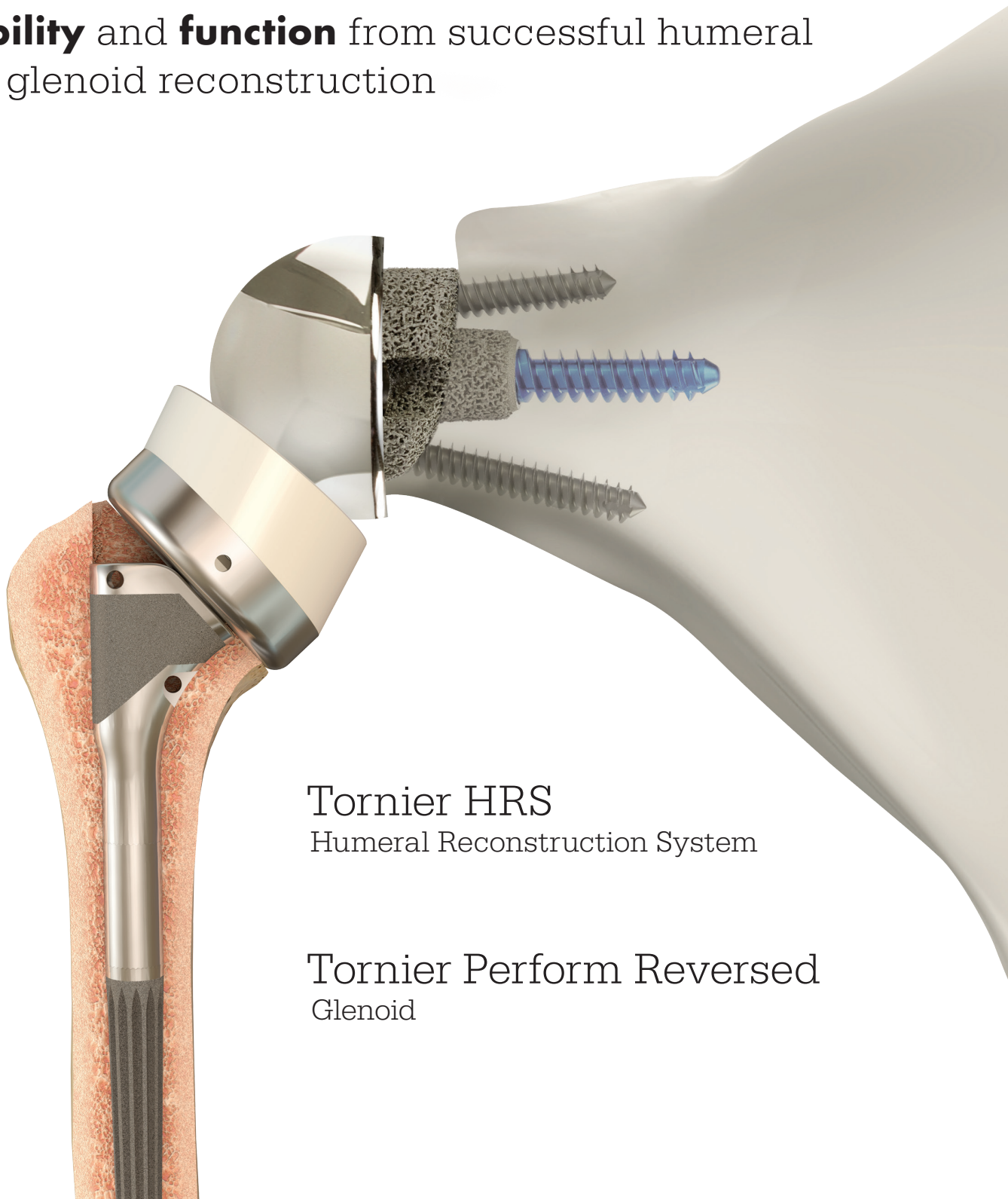
